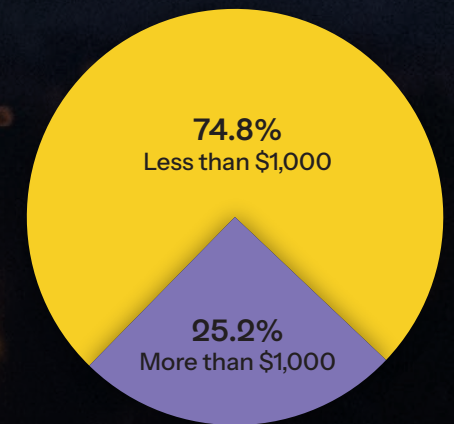

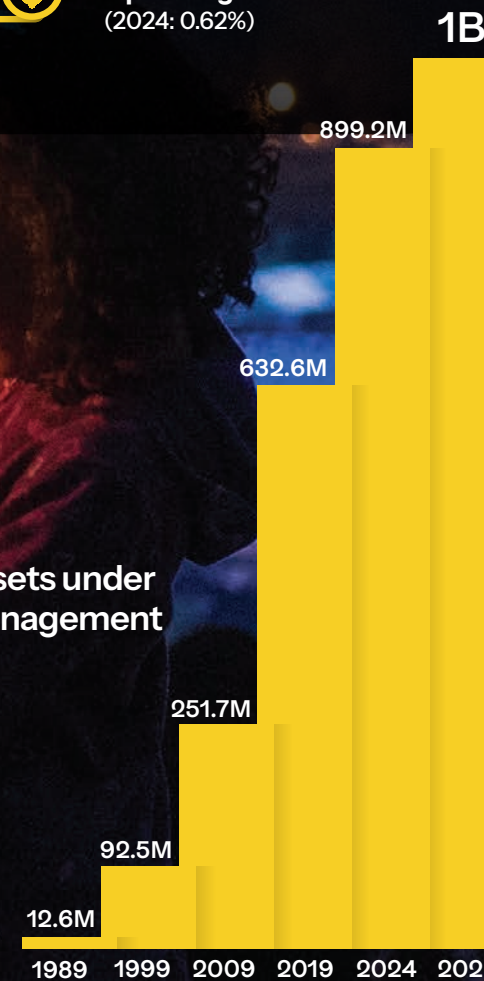

## MESSAGE FROM OUR BOARD CHAIR & CEO

What do you imagine when you think about the flourishing communities you want to see in Edmonton? At Edmonton Community Foundation we see a community where everyone has a place to call home, children and families have the support they need to thrive, and where opportunity is shared. In 2025 we took major steps toward turning this vision into reality.

For the first time, our assets under management surpassed \$1 billion. This reflects the generosity, foresight and trust of our donors. Over the past 36 years, more than 2,600 fund founders have established over 1,850 endowments, helping to shape the city through their philanthropy. Together we granted \$44.7 million to 925 charities and students across the region, bringing our cumulative support to \$484 million since 1990. While ECF remains the fourth largest Community Foundation in Canada, what's even more impressive is that we are one of the younger ones. The speed of our growth is a testament to Edmonton — we are a city that cares for and invests in each other.

This was also a year of focus and momentum as we identified affordable housing and early childhood development as two priority areas where long-term change begins. Edmonton has the people, expertise and will to think differently about these issues. ECF is in a unique position to convene partners, unlock new ideas and drive systemic change in these sectors. When people have stable housing, and when

children have strong starts in life, the ripple effects are felt across entire communities.

In 2025, we committed \$1 million to nine organizations advancing affordable housing, while also working with the Social Enterprise Fund and Edmonton Community Development Company to begin aligning grants, social financing, community partnerships and land to help unlock more options.

We also provided \$2.5 million through 59 grants to projects and initiatives improving outcomes for children ages 0-6. This includes a \$150,000 grant to the University of Alberta's Community University Partnership (CUP) to lead a major research initiative into early childhood development in Edmonton. This work will help ensure that future investments are based on evidence and long-term strategies.

Intentionally committing to two important areas does not reduce our commitment to the broad range of causes and communities we support. Connecting donors to the issues that matter most to them — and being a flexible, responsive funder — remains central to our work. Instead, these focus areas deepen our impact in ways that strengthen outcomes across all sectors of our community.

We are not waiting for the future to arrive. With our donors and community partners, we are shaping the communities we imagine, believe in and build together.

Neither does our city.

# Imagine housing that builds stronger families.

Last year, we identified affordable housing and early childhood development as priorities — areas where long-term change begins. Since then, we have invested \$3.5 million in 68 organizations across both sectors while bringing partners together in new ways. Because sometimes what’s needed isn’t just more funding, but better alignment — connecting public, private and philanthropic leaders to unlock solutions none of us could reach on our own.



## ADVANCING AFFORDABLE HOUSING

When we imagine a city where everyone has a place to call home, projects like The Plexes bring that closer. Led by NiGiNan Housing Ventures, this 28 unit, 56-bed development is supported by a \$200,000 grant from ECF.

But impact isn’t measured in dollars. It’s measured in stability, dignity and the sense of belonging that comes with a safe home.

The Plexes is one of nine commitments we made totalling \$1 million in 2025, part of our broader goal to help house 5,000 Edmontonians by 2028. By combining grants, social financing from the Social Enterprise Fund and convening partners across sectors, we’re helping move housing solutions from idea to reality.

## HELPING CHILDREN START STRONG

A child’s first library book can spark a lifelong love of learning. That’s why we partnered with Edmonton Public Library (EPL) to bring 5,000 new picture books into the hands of families across Edmonton.

This \$100,000 grant was part of a broader commitment to early childhood development — one that saw us provide more than \$2.5 million to 59 projects and initiatives. The earliest years shape everything that follows.

Beyond strengthening their language and literacy skills, these experiences ignite their imaginations. They come to school curious, confident, and ready to learn and grow.

The real impact lives in those everyday moments: a parent reading at bedtime, a child discovering a new idea, a family building connection. These are the moments where every child has the chance to start strong.

## THE BUSINESS OF GIVING BACK

For Mosaic Home Services, giving back is part of how they do business. Through their Mosaic Home Service Community Support Fund and the Knight Family Fund, they’re turning success into something shared — supporting causes that matter to their team of 54 franchisees across Canada.

We work alongside Mosaic to make that giving simple, strategic, and meaningful. This includes structuring their community fund as

a non-endowed fund so that their charitable support can flow to organizations 12 times per year. In 2025, the fund provided \$55,085 to 12 organizations bringing its cumulative support to \$105,085 since it was established in 2024.

But Mosaic’s impact goes beyond the mechanics of giving. It brings their franchisees together to create a culture of giving back to the communities that have helped the company find success.



# Imagine roots that grow into the future.

## CULTURE AND WELLBEING IN ACTION

Now in its second year, the Indigenous Health and Wellness program at TELUS World of Science – Edmonton (TWOSE) is expanding its relationship with Indigenous youth and their families.

Supported by a \$78,100 Community Grant, the program works with students at Braemar School and an Indigenous Advisory Circle to deliver culturally-grounded workshops that strengthen wellbeing and connection to culture.

Programming has included sessions focusing on communication and confidence, nutrition and budgeting and storytelling workshops with Elder Suzan Marie. Participants have also engaged with interactive exhibits at TWOSE including IMAX experiences and the Legends of the Northern Sky in the Zeidler Dome.

By embedding culturally-informed learning within STEAM spaces, TWOSE is supporting Indigenous youth to lead with confidence and connection.

## LEAVING A LEGACY

Seanna Collins first learned about ECF in the 1990s — not as a donor, but as a journalist. While hosting *Day by Day*, CFRN TV, she interviewed two of our founders, Robert Stollery and John Poole. That conversation stayed with her.

It inspired Seanna and her husband to include ECF in their will. They won’t see the impact of their endowment during their lifetime, but they

have planted something that will grow long after — a gift that keeps giving to the causes they care about.

They are one of 724 people and families who have chosen to support their communities in perpetuity through their estate plans. It’s a quiet, profound act of belief in the future — and in the Edmonton yet to come.

## STRENGTH IN STRATEGY

Behind every strong organization is a clear vision for what comes next. With a \$9,000 Small Grant, the Alberta SPCA is blueprinting that future through its 2025-2029 strategic plan.

This work strengthens their role as a collaborator that brings partners together to address root causes of animal neglect, from social challenges to the mental health of animal owners.

By investing in capacity, we’re helping the Alberta SPCA create a more coordinated, compassionate response across the sector.

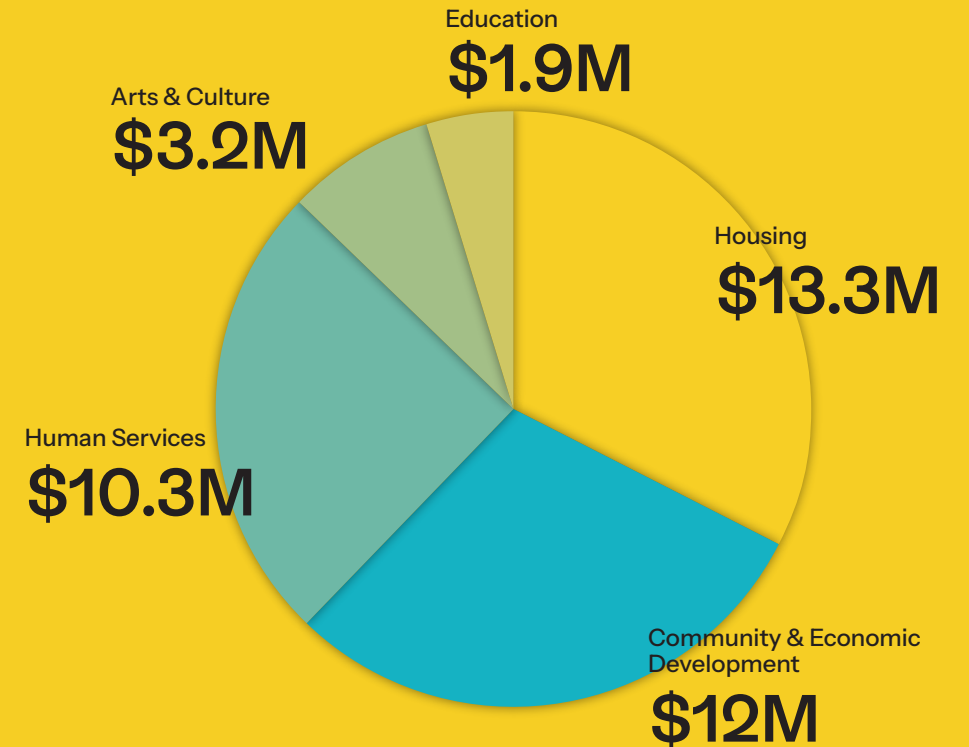
**REINVESTING FOR IMPACT**

Growth looks different when it’s rooted in purpose. With support from our Social Enterprise Fund (SEF), Goodwill Industries of Alberta has expanded its operations across the province, creating more opportunities for individuals with disabilities to find meaningful employment.

Through three loans totalling \$2.7 million, SEF helped fuel that growth. In 2025, Goodwill finished repaying the balance of the loan which means SEF can continue to re-invest in new opportunities.

## YOUNG LEADERS SHAPING WHAT’S NEXT

Cayden Zhang is proof that the community we imagine is already being built by the next generation. As a member of ECF’s Young Edmonton Grants (YEG) committee, Cayden joins fellow youth volunteers in reviewing applications and guiding funding decisions for projects led by young people across the city.

In 2025, the YEG committee directed \$74,200 to 29 projects, bringing our total granting from this program to \$774,081 since 2011.

It’s volunteers like Cayden who keep our work connected to emerging voices — bringing curiosity, care and fresh perspective to every decision.

## ACCELERATING EDUCATION

Education opens doors, but for many students, cost can stand in the way. In 2025, we provided \$1.7 million in Student Awards to 565 students. This includes 197 recipients of our Hilltop Awards and Bursaries program who received a combined \$492,559 in support thanks to 29 endowments that support the program.

This funding is enabling students like Kevin Chavez Laxamana who has received three Hilltop Awards to pursue his post-secondary goals.

Most recently, Kevin has entered Doctor of Education studies at the University of Calgary. The impact of Kevin’s education and passion is already being felt in our community as he helps reshape education as an instructor at NorQuest College. Last year, Kevin was selected as an *Edify* Top 40 Under 40 for creating more inclusive learning spaces for underrepresented and neurodivergent students.

**SUSTAINABILITY THROUGH PARTNERSHIP**

The Beaverhill Bird Observatory (BBO) has been researching and monitoring more than 270 bird species in the Beaverhill Natural Area for the past 40 years. Their conservation work contributes to national and international research projects, and their education programs connect people to crucial ecosystems including more than 10,000 students through its BirdSmart program every year.

Sustaining this work requires more than passion and one-time grants. By partnering with ECF, BBO has created a long-term funding strategy that any mission-driven organization can follow. By building their strategy on the power of endowment, BBO is combining philanthropy, matching programs, and operational support into lasting financial stability through ECF.

Here’s how they did it.

**1. Establish the funds**

Since 2019, BBO and its supporters have established a family of six endowment funds at ECF. Together, they form a reliable financial foundation supporting research, education, and operations over the long term.

**2. Build the strategy**

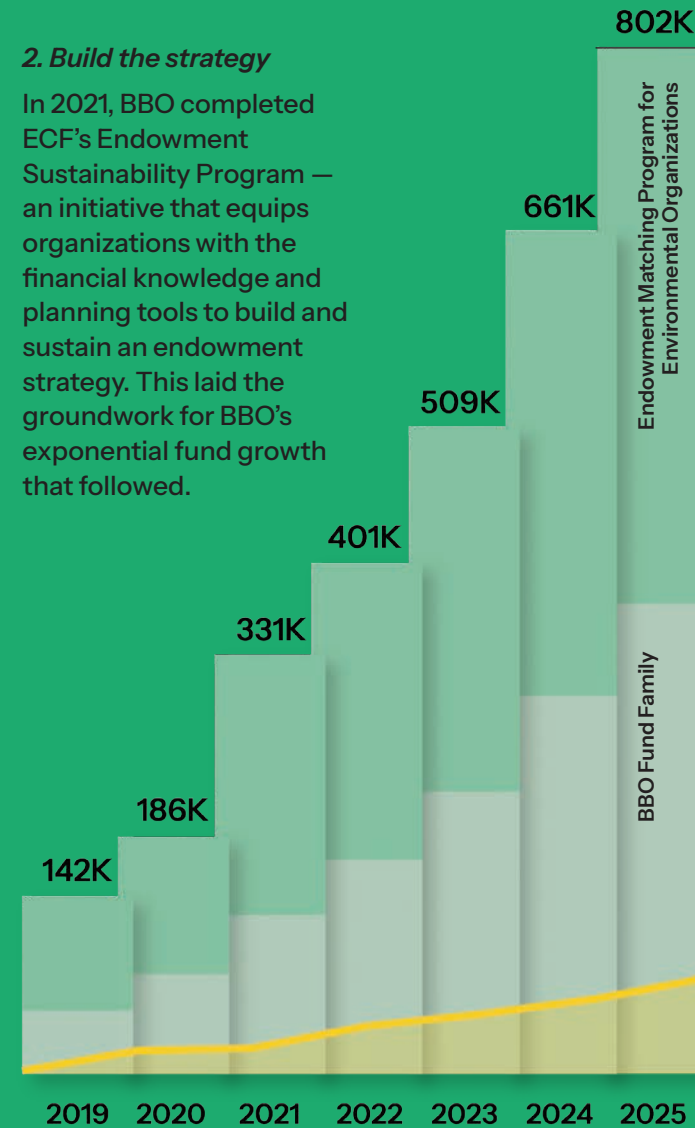
In 2021, BBO completed ECF’s Endowment Sustainability Program — an initiative that equips organizations with the financial knowledge and planning tools to build and sustain an endowment strategy. This laid the groundwork for BBO’s exponential fund growth that followed.

**3. Accelerate with matching**

Through ECF’s Endowment Matching Program for Environmental Organizations (EMPEO), every dollar contributed to BBO’s funds is matched 1:1. Since 2019, \$432,448 in matching funds has helped grow BBO’s endowment to \$801,936 as of December 31, 2025.

**4. Stabilize operations**

Since 2019, BBO has received \$367,401 through various ECF funding streams, including \$185,000 in multi-year Environmental Operating Grants supporting core operations. Alongside this, BBO has received \$87,547 from its endowments, and their funds will continue providing growing, reliable funding for generations to come.
